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ELLIJAY POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT October 2025 PRESENTED November 2025



OVERVIEW:

Activity: Officers of the department conducted 496 activity log entries which includes the following activity for October:

98 total reports received: 37 Crash Reports and 61 Incident Reports which includes one Use of Force Report.

212 traffic stops which resulted in 64 citations and 192 warnings (256 total). The top 5 violations which resulted in citations are as follows:

1. No License; 2. Driving Under the Influence; 3. License suspended / revoked; 4. Failure to maintain lane; and 5. Speeding.

64 intentional pro-active patrols.

5 warrants served (arrests) - 4 misdemeanors and 1 felony.

1 animals running at large on Gartrell Street.

Use of Force: There was one use of force report submitted in October. Sergeant Chastain and Officer Hill responded to a residence regarding a domestic dispute. The suspect was under the influence of alcohol. Sergeant Chastain displayed his taser at the suspect and ordered him out of the house. The suspect complied and was arrested and charged with Simple Battery under the Family Violence Act. No injuries. No deployment of Taser.

TRENDS:

Parking Violations: As demand for parking space has increased in the past month, so has the instances of parking violations (parking in no parking areas, in striped safety zones, and upon sidewalks). Some increase is expected during Apple Festival weekends, but it currently appears to be increasing during the week as well.

Alarm Calls: There were 5 alarm calls in October. Additionally, officers found two open/unsecured doors after hours.

Flock Safety Program: Sergeant McClure was contacted by a Bellingham Washington detective regarding a wanted person possibly being in the City of Ellijay. With only a few photos from the suspect's SnapChat, the detective used the background images to possibly identify the location. Sergeant McClure positively identified the location of the photos as being within and/near the city. On October 26th, Sergeant Chastain's shift was notified by McClure of a description of the

vehicle and that it was possibly in East Ellijay. Officer Morris began searching Flock Cameras for a vehicle meeting that description and obtained a tag number, verifying through a search of agency RMS records the last name of the owner was the same as the suspect. A location was narrowed and officers began looking for the vehicle within the City. Officer Hill found and stopped the vehicle on South Main near the Hitching Post. The driver met the description of the offender, although he had no license or ID on his person. He was positively identified and NCIC/GCIC demonstrated he was the wanted person from Washington State. He was arrested and a fugitive from justice warrant was obtained for his extradition back to Washington. His original offenses were multiple and included sexual assault against a female child.

This incident showcases one of the 28 successful investigative outcomes in which the FlockSafety cameras have been used this year which are indicated in the following table.
